'Greens'

- Salad leaves and fruit scraps, vegetable peelings
- Tea bags and coffee grounds
- Old flowers and nettles
- Grass cuttings



'Browns'

- Wood chippings, twigs, straw, dried leaves
- Vacuum bag contents
- Some shredded or scrunched-up paper, cereal and egg boxes

Use it to feed the lawn, enrich borders, maintain vegetable patches and flower beds.
